

Scholarship – AQW

Objective

Accord financial support to an individual member in good standing to follow a course or a workshop in weaving, spinning or dyeing and to share this knowledge with the AQW membership.

Prerequisites

To have been an AQW member in good standing for the last two (2) consecutive years.

- Letter of recommendation from a member, a weaving teacher, confirming that the candidate has the capacities and the basic weaving skills necessary to fully profit from the experience.
- A *curriculum vitae* as a weaver and photos or slides of articles woven during the last two (2) years.
- Information on the contents of the course (brochure if possible), registration cost, date of the activity, expenses for the required material
- Complete this registration form and send in with the required documents described above.

Aftermath

- A detailed written report on the activity must be submitted to the AQW no later than two (2) months after the end of the activity. This report will be kept in the records and may be published in the bulletin.
- A certificate of proof of attendance at the workshop must be included with the written report.
- Samples or articles relating to the workshop must be made available to members at the next convention.

Cancellation or postponement of the activity

The Board of Directors must be advised within one (1) week.

Personal cancellation

The Board of Directors must be advised within one (1) week. The reasons explaining why the candidate is unable to attend this activity must be given.

The Board of Directors will decide if the scholarship must be returned. Should the scholarship be returned, it will be awarded to another candidate who had applied earlier.

Composition of the selection committee

The Board of Directors, supported by at least one annually selected judge, forms the selection committee.

Amount of the scholarship

\$200.

Maximum one (1) scholarship per three (3) years, per candidate, unless there are no other applications.

Results from the selection committee

The results are announced to all applicants and published in the bulletin.

Calendar

Final date for sending in application (registered mail) : Just before the AQW Convention.

Final decision: One (1) month after the Convention.

Selection criteria

The selection criteria will take into account all of the above-mentioned points.

All the decisions taken by the selecting committee will be final.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel this project at any time.
